

We served 157 guests, and our net income was \$1,696.84. Homemade soups were the most popular (\$364.50); some people came exclusively for them. Also, we sold \$146.75 in baked goods. Donations were also at an all-time high (\$127.00).

This was the biggest fundraiser EVER and will go to the Building Fund of Christ's Church when the checks are written in June. However, our salad bars are so much more than the money. At this salad bar, five people sought Fr. Jeff for prayers and concerns, another important ministry that is happening.






