The 2015 audit was approved. A thank you was sent to Jeff Simpson for completing this.

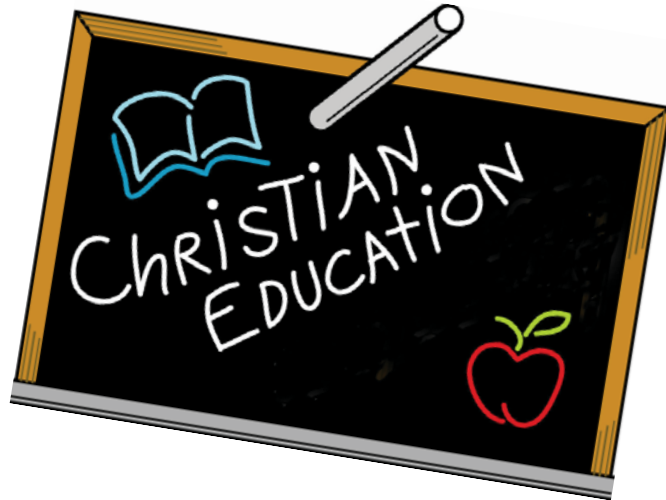
The vestry approved taking the balance of the new piano after memorial donations were applied out of the Memorial Fund.

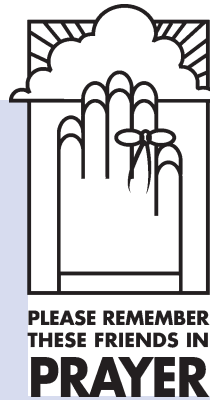
