

## Christ's Church Ushers

The most important function is to greet and hand out the bulletins as the worshippers enter the church, paying particular attention to visitors. After the service has begun, the ushers take a count and adjust the number of wafers accordingly. They also ascertain if any worshipper prefers to receive his or her communion in the pew and fills the request card. The ushers are responsible to notify the celebrant of the required action.

The ushers also select the element bearers, paying particular attention to birthdays, anniversaries, or any other appropriate reason. The ushers are responsible to notify the worshippers when they may proceed to the altar for communion in an orderly manner.

During holiday and funeral services, the ushers determine if the center rail is needed and set in place after the offertory and remove it immediately after communion.
